SUNDAY.

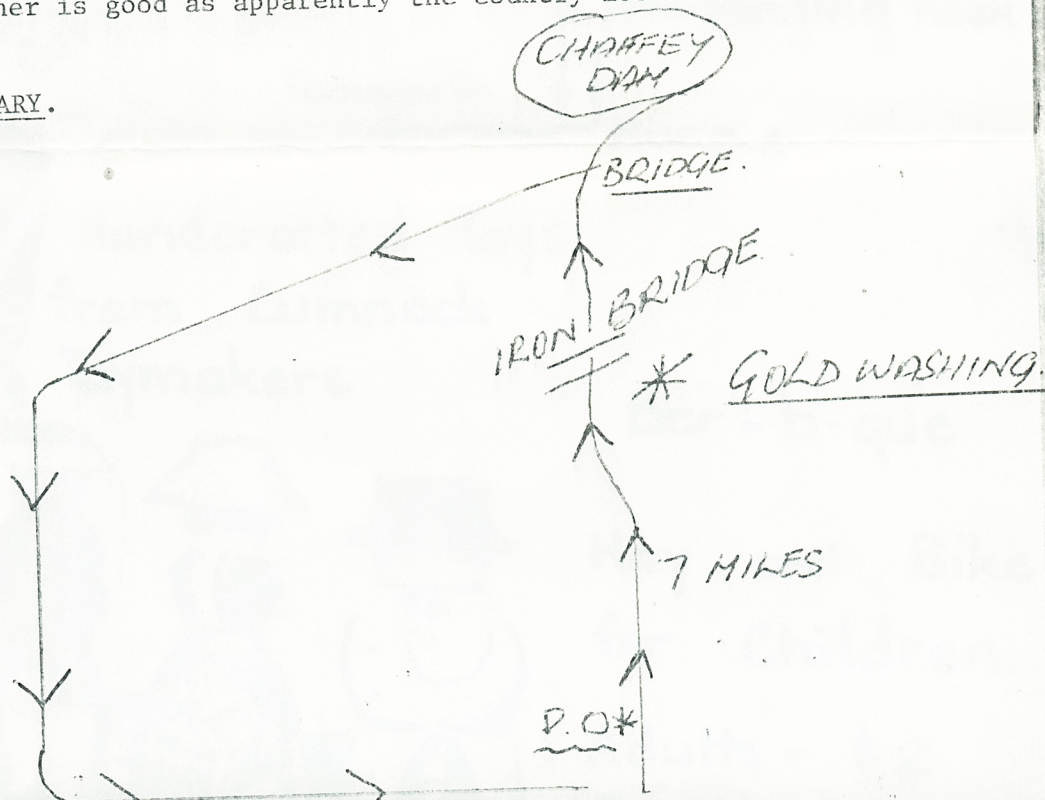
9.00 am. Members of the Classic and Specialist Car Club will meet us at the recreation grount adjacent to the Hotel for a motorcana.

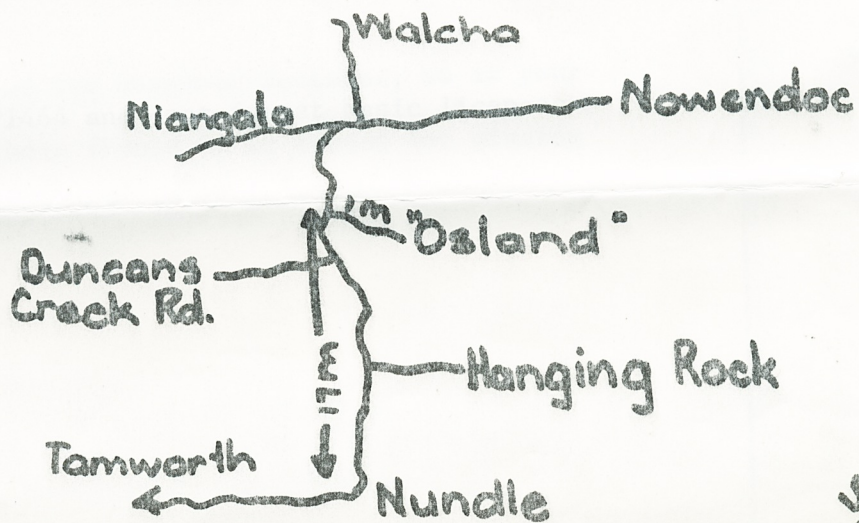
