1968 LONDON SYDNEY MARATHON WHERE IT ALL STARTED






1965 FORD MUSTANG



- Left hand drive, purchased in 1988 by Terry Daly.
- Ran in Variety Club Bash and proved wanting in chassis and 289 engine departments.
- Tony Williams built a full roll cage, strengthened and seam welded the body.
- Also added the twin shocks and large fuel tank in the rear seats space. Four piston brake calipers front and rear.
- Bob Brill built Boss 351 and 4 speed top loader ... now 370ci
- Finished for the 1993 LSM

1993 LONDON - SYDNEY MARATHON



- Gordon & Kim Ketelby (# 43) finished 37th out of 86 finishers.
- Terry Daly & Bob Brill (# 73) finished 72nd
 - Broke an axle in India when running 4th and repaired it then drove 20km by torchlight with Bob on the bonnet.
 - Sponsored by Roger Morgan/Xerox
- Les & Roselee Johnson (# 53) retired
 - Les was dumped in a horse trough to avoid dying of dehydration.







1995 LONDON - MEXICO RALLY



- Terry Daly & Bob Brill finished 9th outright and 3rd in Class D
 - Part of Team Ausford, winners of the Team Prize.
- Les Johnson & Gordon Ketelby finished 32nd









1997 PANAMA - ALASKA RALLY



- Terry Daly & Bob Brill won Class D and finished 4th overall behind 3 Porsches
- Les Johnson & Jim Peters broke a stub axle & fell 3 days behind
 - Drove 63 hours to catch up last 39 without sleep and won the "Great Catchup Award" at Anchorage




2000 LONDON - SYDNEY MARATHON










- Ended the stage at Cooma Motorfest with evening dinner and an auction at Cooma Car Club including a peek at their Museum.












